Resolution #1, District Conference 2009 (APPROVED):

Whereas the Maritime District Conference, by Conference resolution, has affirmed the continuance of the ministry of Camp Evangeline;

And Whereas Camp Evangeline currently operates as a ministry of the Maritime District, with the District Executive serving as its board;

And Whereas Camp Evangeline has its own status as a Registered Charity under the Income Tax Act of Canada;

And Whereas By-Law IX of the Maritime District Constitution and By-Laws states in reference to Camp Evangeline, "The management of all District Camp Meetings shall be determined by regulations established by the District Conference";

Be it Resolved that a plan be developed to make Camp Evangeline a self-governing entity affiliated with the Maritime District of the Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada;

And Be It Further Resolved that this plan be brought back to a future conference for final approval.
