

Parent Information

Cost: The total cost for Kids Kamp 2010 is \$225. Catch our **SUPER SAVINGS** rate of \$200 by getting your form in (postmarked or online) by **June 7, 2010!**

Registration: Complete the application on the back of this flyer and submit payment in full. Money paid is refundable if registration is cancelled before June 24, 2010.

Capacity: Space is limited, so get your form in early! Kids Kamp operates on a “first come” basis.

Canteen: Children may spend up to \$20 during the week. If parents want their child to use the canteen they should submit up to an additional \$20 with registration payment. Each child will then be able to spend \$4/day from their “account”.

Arrival: Arrive between 2:00 pm and 3:00 pm on June 29th. Register immediately upon arrival. Please **DO NOT** arrive before 2:00 pm.

What is Kids Kamp? Kids Kamp is an annual Christian camping event for kids age 7-11. It takes place at Camp Evangeline in Debert, NS. Kids Kamp is hosted by the Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada – Maritime District.

What can campers expect? Campers can expect to be involved in lots of activities, games, crafts, swimming, and laughs! Each morning and evening kids will develop their faith in Jesus at special kid’s services. Kids Kamp is as much fun and faith-building as we can possibly pack into one week!

Who are the ministry guests this year? We are excited to have a wonderful maritime ministry team: Pastor Laura Hurlbert-Nickerson and Pastor Chad Nickerson. These children’s specialists are experts in Maritime children’s ministry and have a heart and passion for the children in our region. Your child will be blessed by them!

What to Bring? Bible, notepad, pen, comfortable clothes for outdoor activities, clothes for “messy” games, sleeping bag, pillow, personal toiletries, sunscreen, swimwear, towels, shoes for water games, water bottle, and medications. (All medications must be given to the Camp Nurse on arrival.)

Telephone: It is recommended, to prevent homesickness, campers not receive or make calls home. If however, you would like your child to call you during the week you **MUST** provide them with a calling card. The office phone is only available for emergencies.

Technology Free: Camp Evangeline is technology free. Campers are not permitted to bring cell phones, ipods, mp3 players, computers, etc. because of theft and distractions.

Lice Policy: Head lice is a common nuisance for many operations working with large numbers for children. It can be an embarrassing issue for those unfortunate enough to come in contact with the bug, yet it is easily treated. For everyone’s assurance, each child must be thoroughly checked for lice before arriving at Camp Evangeline and may be checked by the Camp Nurse. **PLEASE NOTE: As we do not have the facilities to treat this issue, any child found with lice must return home for treatment. They may return when they are entirely clear of lice and/or nits.**

Please provide a detailed description of your child’s medical conditions or allergies when submitting your registration form and re-confirm the list with the Camp Nurse upon arrival.

Pick-up: Please pick up your child no later than 2:00 pm on Saturday, July 3rd. Parents are invited to attend the final Kids Kamp Service at 1:00 pm on Saturday. Note: On registration day, you will have to declare who will be picking up your child on the last day of Kids Kamp.

Visitors: For the safety of ALL children, unscheduled visitors (including parents) are not allowed on the premises during the camp. If you plan to visit your child, please make arrangements prior to camp week. Absolutely no overnight guests are permitted.
