

Parent information

Cost: The total cost for Kids Kamp 2012 is \$225. Catch our **SUPER SAVINGS** rate of \$200 by getting your form in (postmarked or online) by **June 11, 2012!**

Registration: Complete the application on the back of this flyer, and submit payment in full.

Capacity: Space is limited, so get your form in early! Kids Kamp operates on a “first come” basis.

Canteen: Children may spend \$20 during the week. If parents want their child to use the canteen, they should submit up to an additional \$20 with registration payment. Each child will then be able to spend \$4/day from their “account.” Any monies remaining can be donated to MAK (Missions And Kids).

Arrival: Arrive between 2pm and 3pm on July 3rd. Register immediately upon arrival. Please do not arrive before 2:00pm.

What is Kids Kamp?

Kids Kamp is an annual Christian camping event for kids age 7-11. It takes place at Camp Evangeline in Debert, NS. Kids Kamp is hosted by the Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada - Maritime District.

What can campers expect?
