

YOUTH CAMP 2010

August 2 - 7

Age Limit: This camp is for teens between the ages of 12 and 18 years.

Cost: Early Bird rate is \$200 before June 28th, \$225 before July 7, 2010, \$20 late fee charged for applications received after the July 7 deadline. Those applicants whose applications are received after the camp is full will be placed on a waiting list. They will be returned their deposit if a place does not come available. Deposits will not be returned for those who are accepted for Camp but choose not to attend. Those who cancel their accepted registration cannot designate who will fill their vacant spot. Vacant spots will be given to the next individual on the waiting list.

On-site registration will occur from 5:00pm - 6:00pm on Monday, Aug 2nd, please do not arrive before 5:00 pm. Those who arrive late may lose their registration to others on the registration waiting list.

Please be aware that THERE WILL BE NO SWITCHING OF ROOMS OR ROOMMATES. It is possible that you may not have your preferred roommate. Please do not ask the leadership to make room changes.

Supervision: Youth Camp is organized from the Maritime District. The Youth Camp Committee, and its appointed representatives, will manage all disciplinary action. The Zero Tolerance Rules, as published in this packet, will be strictly enforced. "Zero Tolerance" means that any violation of such will result in immediate dismissal from the Camp. Those dismissed from the Camp are responsible for their own transportation off the premises at their own expense. All inappropriate behavior should be reported to the Camp Director, a counsellor or Camp Committee Member. A report on the misbehavior, and any action taken, will be filed in the Church Ministries records.

Zero Tolerance Rules:

1. Vandalism (any sort, from any means including rough-housing, etc.)
2. Possession of Illegal Drugs or Alcohol
3. Presence in a Room/Cabin of Someone of the Opposite Sex
4. Participation in any Sexually Immoral Act
5. Participation in any Physical or Verbal Assault
6. Participation in any Illegal Act

Boundary Lines: Each delegate must stay on the Camp grounds unless they are accompanied by an officially appointed person. The acceptable area of travel during the Camp will be highlighted on the first day of Camp. It is the Camper's responsibility to make themselves aware of the boundary limits.

Spending Money: There will be canteen service available during the week of Youth Camp. Campers should bring extra spending money.

Visitors: For the safety of all campers visitors are NOT permitted on site at any time.

Camp ends at 1:00 pm on Saturday.

Packing Your Suitcase: Bring: Bible, notepad, bedding, towels, toiletries, old clothing, modest clothing, swim-wear, sun-screen, and a water bottle. Do not bring: Stereos, fireworks, water-guns, balloons, or "trouble-causing" material. The Camp reserves the right to confiscate any material/item that the Youth Camp Committee deems as inappropriate. All medications must be given to the camp nurse, including non-prescriptive medication, ie. Tylenol, Advil, allergy medication, etc.
